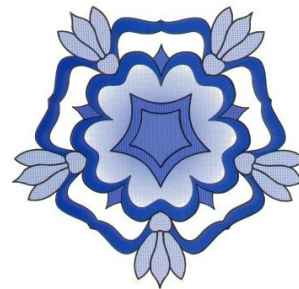


Water in classes

Absence

If your child is unwell please keep them at home and notify the school. If we have not heard from you then we will contact you. If your child has to be taken out of school for visits to doctors, dentists etc please make sure the school is informed.

Accidents and Illness

If a serious accident or illness occurs at school then parents will be contacted. In the case of immediate medical attention the school will contact the medical services. It is essential that school has an up to date contact number so parents can be easily reached.

Uniform

The children always look very smart in their uniform, most of which can be purchased from the office. A white T-shirt and black shorts for indoor P.E. can also be bought from the office. Longer tracksuit clothing for outdoor games in the winter months is recommended.



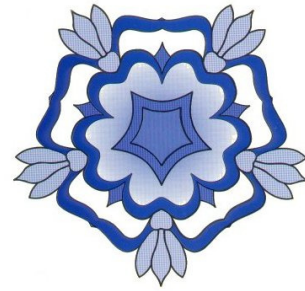

Behaviour and discipline

Self discipline is our ultimate aim and it is hoped that children will learn to respect each other and show tolerance to all within our school community. Good behaviour is actively encouraged and positive reinforcement is used by all staff.

Complaints procedure

Should a problem or difficulty arise concerning your child, we would hope that, in the first instance, you contact the school - the class teacher or Headteacher. In the unlikely event that the situation is not resolved, parents should follow our complaints procedure available on the school website or from the school office.

Sex and Relationship Education

Our children are given opportunities to consider and reflect upon the wide variety of different relationships they have with others. Across the school, children develop their relationships and social skills through the delivery and teaching of the S.E.A.L. (Social and Emotional Aspects of Learning) units of work utilising Gloucestershire PinK curriculum

Aspects of sex education are taught in accordance with the government guidelines as an integral part of their class curriculum.

Parents are notified in order that (if needs be), they may advise the school should they wish to withdraw their child from any aspects of the programme according to government guidelines.

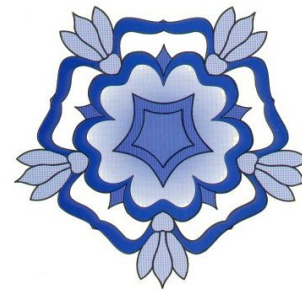

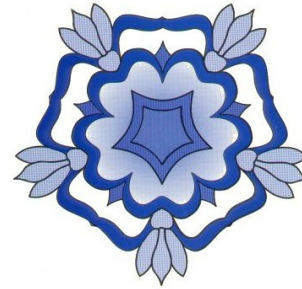
Engaging lessons

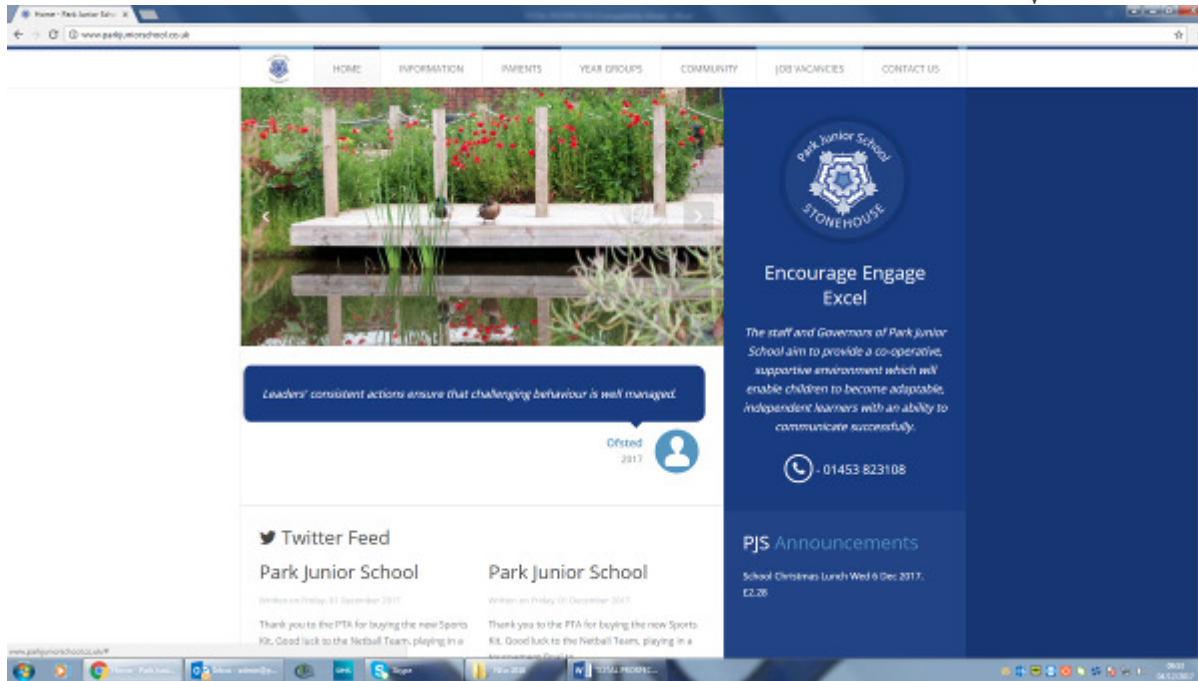
