

E safety tips for parents

- As in normal parenting set appropriate boundaries for your child's "on line" life
- Speak to your child about possible risks and provide advice and guidance
- Do you know your child's "on line " friends ?
- "Stranger Danger "exists on line . Talk to your child about it.
- Your child should not share photos that they would not be happy to share with you
- Talk to your child about technologies and what they may see on line
- People may not be who they said they are on line
- Encourage your child to " think before sharing or sending "
- Encourage your child to " think about the consequences"
- Once posted on line you lose control
- Always keep personal information safe
- Never agree to meet anyone you meet on line
- If it is not acceptable in " real life" it is not acceptable on line
- Encourage your child to talk to you or someone else if they are concerned
- Use age ratings when selecting games for your child.
- Be involved in your child's gaming experiences
- Use parental controls

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
